## Munchkin Camp (preschool)

Half day camp full of fun and activities for kids 4 yrs. old through kindergarten. Campers will learn basic skills of tennis, swimming and sports play. Additional activities focused on motor skill improvement will be emphasized. "On-site" field trips will make the end of the week fun and exciting. There will be time for arts and crafts projects including weekly awards for achieving certain skills.

## Elementary Camp

Kids who attended first through sixth grade will have a blast at our all day camp. Campers will have their choice of lunch options (no additional charge). Activities will include sports specific focus in tennis, swimming, and fitness based training. Throughout the week they will also participate in fun educational activities such as photography, tie dying and more. Special visits will be made by local professionals including Boonshoft Museum.

## Tennis Fun Camp

This exciting camp is a combination of tennis and swimming. It will offer tennis, a snack and supervised swimming to break up the 3 hours. Each day will start with an hour of tennis working on strokes, fundamentals and technique. We then take a snack/swimming break for an hour. Finally we finish with some tennis games, some point play and a "fun finish". This camp is for the 12 and under palyer.

# Frequently Asked Questions

## ***What does the camp fee include?***

Depending upon which camp a child is registered for, the camp fee includes tennis instruction, swim instruction, open swim, organized games-sports and crafts, in-house field trips and lunch with beverage and snacks.

## ***What should my child bring to camp?***

Gym shoes, swimsuit, sunscreen, towel, water bottle, and tennis racquet. (We have a limited number of demo racquets if you do not have one).

## ***Do you accommodate special needs/food requests, etc?***

We will make every attempt to accommodate all special needs. Please call to discuss any special needs.

## ***Can a non-member participate in the camp?***

We welcome non-members to participate in the camp. However, non-members pay a slightly higher fee than members.

## ***What is the Five Seasons refund policy?***

Refunds will be given only with a physician's form relative to injury incurred or medical condition, or under special circumstances, approved by the Camp Director. All registrations are subject to a non-refundable registration fee of \$50.00. No refunds will be issued once camp has begun.

## ***What other forms are required other than the Camper Registration Form?***

Once the camper is accepted into the camp, he/she will be mailed an information packet, which includes a photo release form, emergency contact information, medical information, and a disclaimer. The camper will also receive confirmation of the camp dates he/she registered for and any fees still due to Five Seasons as well as drop off/pick up information.

## ***What are "in-house" field trips?***

Five Seasons is pleased to offer field trips on Fridays, which are held here at the club. The children do not go off premises – we bring the field trip to the club! A variety of interesting activities like a magician, zoo animals, search and rescue dogs, and more are planned for this summer.

## ***What is the camp schedule?***

Depending upon which camp the child is registered for will dictate what schedule your child will follow. Based on the camper's attendance, some activities may not be available. The camp offers a rotation of swim instruction, tennis instruction, and other activities. Counselors have the flexibility to change some of the activities based on camper interest.

## ***Does a camper need to be potty trained?***

All campers must be potty trained.

## ***When will I have confirmation that my child is enrolled in the camp?***

If we receive your camper registration form prior to the priority deadline and space is available, we will confirm enrollment by postcard or email. However, registration packets will not be mailed out until mid-May.

## ***What is the drop-off/pick-up procedure?***

You may drop your child off at the Gatehouse at the pool entrance. If it is raining you may drop off your child at the portico. On the first day you will be required to ensure all paperwork is correctly completed before leaving your child. All other days you will be required to sign-in and sign-out your child. If someone other than the authorized parent or guardian is to pick-up your child you will need to make arrangements and provide written authorization. No child will be released to anyone who has not been authorized to pick up the child. Please call to make arrangements for special circumstances.

## ***Can I make a change to my child's registration?***

After June 5th, changes will be accepted on a case-by-case basis.
