Frequently Asked Questions

How do I sign up? All interested campers will be mailed an information packet, which includes a photo release form, emergency contact information, medical information, and a disclaimer. The camper will also receive confirmation of the camp sessions he/she registered for and any fees still due to Five Seasons as well as drop off/pick up information. Completed forms are accepted at the Member Service Desk or by mail. You will receive confirmation of your registration. Registration forms must be turned in one week prior to the week of camp your child is attending.

Will there be Pre-Registration? Yes! We will be hosting a pre-registration two-day event where parents will be able to take advantage of special savings! We will have a pre-registration table located in the club's lobby that will have camp information as well as all the forms needed to enroll your child in camp. Parents will receive an average savings of 10% on all pre-registrations completed and turned in before April 1st, 2010. Pre-Registration Dates: Wednesday, March 24th, 6 – 9 pm and Saturday, March 27th, 9am-12pm.

Who are the counselors? We require that all counselors ENJOY working with children. A large percentage of the counselors are college students who have camp experience or high school students who have experience working with children. Each counselor attends a summer camp training workshop prior to the start of camp.

What is the drop-off/pick-up procedure? To avoid congestion in the driveway, please park your car in the east parking lot and walk your child into the front entrance of the club and downstairs to the Kids Zone. Counselors will greet campers and ask you to sign-in your child. Counselors will be on hand when children are ready to be picked-up, where you will sign-out your child. Please call to make arrangements for special circumstances.

What does an average day entail? The day begins with a rotation of activities such as tennis lessons, swim lessons, and a fitness/sports class. After which, lunch is served and the campers then participate in an all-camp activity until 1:30 pm when Special Events or afternoon activities will begin. All campers will be given a snack at 2:00 pm and the day ends at 3:00 pm.

Is lunch included? YES! All campers will receive lunch and a beverage each day. Full day campers will also have a snack in the afternoon. Full menus will be included in the parent packets before camp begins. If a camper decides to bring his/her lunch, please make sure that it is disposable. Campers who have certain food allergies may want to bring their own lunch / snack.

Do you accommodate special needs/food requests, etc? We will make every attempt to accommodate all special needs. Please call to discuss any special needs.

What should my child wear? Each child should wear tennis shoes and comfortable clothes in order to participate in activities. Your camper will receive a Camp Five Seasons t-shirt during the first week they participate in camp.

Does a camper need to be potty trained? All campers must be potty trained.

What should my child bring/pack? We recommend that each camper have a backpack with a spare set of clothes, swimsuit, towel, tennis racquet, sprayable sunscreen, and a large plastic bag for soiled or wet clothes, in case of any accidents. We also recommend that parents label their child's belongings with a permanent marker to help eliminate campers losing belongings.

What should I do if I know my camper is going to be absent? Call 317.582.1550 and ask for the summer camp director or administrative assistant. Leave a message and let us know your camper's name and the date(s) they will be absent. If we do not receive a phone call, you can expect to hear from us the morning your child is not at camp.

Is there a registration fee? There is a \$50 non-refundable registration fee for all campers. Five Seasons members will receive this \$50 towards their first week of camp.

Can I make a change to my child's registration? After June 1st, changes will be accepted on a case-by-case basis. Payment is due prior to the start of camp. If payment is not received, your child will be denied access to camp.

What is the Five Seasons refund policy? All registrations are subject to a non-refundable registration fee of \$50.00. No refunds will be issued once camp has begun, unless a physician's form relative to injury incurred or medical condition is submitted, or under special circumstances approved by the Camp Director.

Can Non-Members Participate in Camp? Yes! Non-members can participate in camp however they pay a slightly higher fee than members.
